


# Cochrane Organisational Dashboard Q1 (Jan-Mar) 2018


#### **Commentary & Achievements**

- Usage of cochrane.org has increased 44% on the same period in 2017, with 71% of visits coming from non-English language browsers, driven mainly by strong growth in Spanish-speaking countries and Brazil
- Usage of the Cochrane Library has increased 10% on the same period in
- Royalties (central income) were down due to the impact of the GBP/USD exchange rate, but in real terms, sales of licences to the Cochrane Library were up
- Central income and expenditure were both tracking lower than expected
- Progress by the Central Executive Team and Cochrane Community in delivering the 2018 Strategy to 2020 Targets was on track, with the exception of the launch of the improved Cochrane Library, which remains delayed
- 91% of new Cochrane Reviews were published with a Summary of Findings table, up from 70% on the same period in 2015
- Overall production of Cochrane Reviews and Cochrane Clinical Answers was up

PURPLE: not started or N/A; RED: serious concerns; AMBER: some delays; GREEN: on target







Goal One







# Notes on the data

- Access denied means a user tried to download a full text, but did not have a subscription to the Cochrane Library. Demand is the combination of successful full text views and attempted full text views (access denied). Data is for Q1 for each of the years shown and excludes usage of Biblioteca Cochrane Plus.
- This is a measure of sessions of the cochrane.org website Compared with 1Q17: Reviews: 31% ↓; Updates: 13% ↓; Protocols: 45% ↓
- 3% YOY decrease in royalties. Currency fluctuation has had a negative effect on income.
- The figures presented for income and expenditure are year to date i.e. 1 January to 31 March. Figures include
- Target four is amber because there have been some delays involving the library re-launch. These data are based on all reviews and updates published in 1Q18. Of the 7 new reviews without SoF tables, 5
- had no included studies and 2 were methodology reviews. Of the 6 updates without SoF tables, 3 had no included studies
