

If you are importing records into the CRS, you may get the following message:

The CRS checks the main bibliographic fields as the records are being read into the database. If less than 50% of the fields are populated, this message is generated.

It acts as a check as to whether you have chosen the correct import filter, and if you know that there should be data in the blank fields, it is a good indication that you need to try again with a different filter.

There is a Quick Ref PDF guide on import filters (see <https://community.cochrane.org/sites/default/files/uploads/G1a%20-%20Which%20import%20filter.pdf>) which will guide you to the correct export style and import filter for commonly used databases.

However, if you know that the field is likely to be blank (for example ,the pages field in a set of trials registry records) then you can ignore the warning, click “Import now” and go ahead with the import.
