

Cochrane Council's aim & purpose

Ensure that Cochrane Groups retain an effective voice in Cochrane's leadership and strategic decision-making.

The purpose of the Council is to provide:



- A forum for Cochrane Groups to consider high-level matters affecting Cochrane as a whole;
- A mechanism to raise matters and provide input to the Governing Board on behalf of Cochrane Groups and members; and
- A forum to consider matters at the request of the Governing Board and **inform Board deliberations**.

New Council constituency

- At its teleconference on 14 April, Council members voted **unanimously** to create two Council seats for members of the Early Career Professionals Network.
- The Early Career Professionals group aims to provide its members with opportunities to enhance their knowledge, skills, and expertise by providing a platform for international networking with early career professionals or other members in the Cochrane community.







Increased Governing Board & Council connection



- Council Co-Chairs now attend Governing Board meetings as non-voting attendees
- Governing Board Co-Chairs attend Council meetings in the same capacity
- Board and Council Co-Chairs meet every two months by videoconference



Key activities in 2021

- Draft **monitoring and evaluation framework** for organizational priorities
- Establishment of 'Emeritus' and 'Lifetime' membership of Cochrane



Special focus on planned changes to Cochrane Review Groups

We have heard from our Cochrane Review Group (CRG) representatives that:

- The **wellbeing** of Cochrane CRG and Network staff is currently a serious concern;
- For many Cochrane is a 'belief system' not just a job, and this needs to be recognized;
- The new Editorial Management System (EMS) is an additional burden

We are working with the **Board Co-Chairs**, and **Editor in Chief** Karla Soares-Weiser, to address these concerns



Priorities for 2022

- Improved communication
- Further input on the future of Cochrane Community and Cochrane Library
- Leading the development of a Cochranewide 'statement of values', as proposed by the Consumer Executive
- A review of the Council's own **Terms of Reference** and representation in light of changes to the organization's structure
