Since the 2022 Russian invasion of Eastern Ukraine, the National Health System has faced significant **challenges** in maintaining quality healthcare, with the conflict severely impacting the **health** of the population.

Supported by Italian and Ukrainian institutions, the project aims to strengthen **hospital** capacity in Lviv, Kyiv, and Dnipro, focusing on improving care for **victims** of explosive devices.

This online course, delivered through eight webinars, aims to **equip** Ukrainian healthcare workers with:

- **Scientific knowledge** on developing evidence-based clinical practice recommendations.
- **Practical skills** to create and implement specialized health protocols and guidelines.
- **Expertise** in adapting actionable recommendations to their local context.

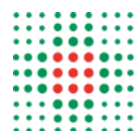

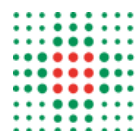

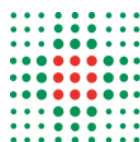
