


The event was moderated by the Rector, Academician of RAS Dmitry A. Sychev and Professor Liliya Eu. Ziganshina.

In the first report, Prof. Yaolong Chen spoke about the main development directions of Cochrane China and the WHO Collaborating Centre for Clinical Guidelines Implementation and Knowledge Translation at Lanzhou University, the RIGHT clinical guideline assessment tool, scientific

research in the field of clinical guideline registration PREPARE and the use of artificial intelligence in the development and assessment of clinical guidelines ADVANCED.



Professor Janne Estill presented the report "Conflict of Interest in the Development of Evidence-Based Approaches to Increasing Life Expectancy", in which he spoke about the types of conflict of interest, existing problems in the area of conflict of interest in clinical guidelines and tools for its assessment, as well as the problem of polymorbidity and polypharmacy, which is inevitably associated with increasing life expectancy.



Professor L.E. Ziganshina in the report "Cochrane systematic reviews for improving quality of life and healthy longevity" noted the main areas of WHO activity for healthy longevity and active ageing, presented information from current Cochrane systematic reviews in the field of improving health, quality and life expectancy of the population.


